



# The 48th Buenos Aires International Book Fair in numbers

More than 1,126,000 visitors visited the 42,163.5 m2 of exhibition space during the 19 days of the 48th Buenos Aires International Book Fair. This large number of visitors shows that the Fair continues to be the great cultural event in Latin America and that, despite the crisis, its halls, proposals and activities have been full since the opening day.



**Sunday, May 12:** Fundación El Libro, organizer of the Buenos Aires International Book Fair, announces the closing figures of an edition that ends with highly positive numbers in relation to the current socioeconomic context.
